TOWN CLERK'S RECORD BOOK

GENERAL ASSISTANCE

The Lockport Township Board of Trustees met in the Central Square Board Room 318, 222 East Ninth Street, Lockport, Illinois on Monday May 9, 2016 at 7:13 PM with Supervisor Ron Alberico presided.

Present were Trustees, John Batusich, Barb Boyce, Mike Lewandowski and Dean Morelli, Clerk Denise Mushro Rumchak, Highway Commissioner John Cielenski, Collector Lance McCalla, Deputy Clerk Jessica Strickland and Grant Spooner filming the meeting. Absent was Assessor Debbi Mason and Attorney Gary Mueller. The meeting agenda was posted at the Lockport & Crest Hill Libraries, the Joliet Herald News, at the Central Square Building, the Lockport Township website (Clerk's section) and also on the Board Room door.

On a Motion of Boyce, seconded by Morelli to approve minutes from the previous meeting as presented for April 11, 2016 regular monthly meeting.

MOTION CARRIED

Trustee Morelli requested a form indicating how many residents are enrolled in the current programs to better understand the current bill amounts more accurately for every Board meeting. There was additional discussion with the Board about different bill amounts. Supervisor Alberico commented that he will get the information from the General Assistance Clerk.

Trustee Batusich questioned bill line item for rent. He was interested to know who receives the check. Supervisor Alberico replied that the rent check goes directly to the property owner, not to the tenant.

Trustee Morelli inquired about the relief section, bill line item marked miscellaneous. He was curious what bills come out of this line item. Supervisor Alberico commented for this month, it was for Ice Mountain water and the Will County Clerk.

On a Motion of Batusich, seconded by Boyce to approve total bills and payroll in the amount of \$11,865.15. Roll call vote resulted in Alberico Aye, Batusich Aye, Boyce Aye, Lewandowski Aye and Morelli Aye.

New Business- Supervisor Alberico read the renewal policy of \$2,360.00 for the Medical Assistance Catastrophic Insurance (MACI). He advised the Board that this insurance policy is necessary to have.

On the Motion of Lewandowski, seconded by Batusich, to approve the renewal of the Medical Assistance Catastrophic Insurance. Roll call vote resulted in Alberico Aye, Batusich Aye, Boyce Aye, Lewandowski Aye, and Morelli Aye.

Old Business- Supervisor Alberico informed the Board with the approval of the budget, the Will County Center for Community Concerns will receive the Lockport Township's financial support of \$ 1,500.00 to address the needs of low-income individuals and families who reside in Will County, Illinois. Supervisor Alberico also added that Lockport Township residents alone received \$532,668.05 in direct client assistance which utilized 1,036 services.

On a Motion of Batusich, seconded by Lewandowski to adjourn the meeting at 7:25 PM.
