A workshop meeting was held on Monday, January 11, 2016 6:30 PM at 222 E. Ninth Street, Lockport, Illinois, in the office of the Supervisor, Room 310 for the purpose of discussing:

- * Zoning changes for new building
- * Part-time maintenance staff – new building

Present were Supervisor Ron Alberico, Trustees John Batusich, Barb Boyce, Michael Lewandowski and Dean Morelli, Clerk Denise Rumchak, Assessor Debbi Mason, Highway Commissioner John Cielenski, Deputy Clerk, Michele Rutter and residents Grant Spooner, filming the meeting, and Tom Kelley. Attorney Mueller arrived at 6:58 PM.

Supervisor Alberico stated that he had done extensive research since the board last discussed zoning for the new building. He read off a list of professional people he consulted with, including attorneys, a construction manager, an architect, the Utility Management manager and Will County Planning and Zoning personnel as to their opinion on zoning for the new building either through the City of Lockport or through Will County. The majority recommended that zoning through annexation with the City of Lockport was the best option.

There was a lengthy discussion with the Board. Supervisor Alberico said they will vote on this at the monthly meeting following the Workshop.

Supervisor Alberico said he would like the Board to consider approving a part-time maintenance person for the new building. He went on to explain the need for this position. A vote for approval will be requested at the monthly meeting following this workshop.
