2016-2017
TOWN FUND BUDGET

The Lockport Township Board of Trustees met in the Central Square Meeting Room, Room 318, 222 East Ninth Street, Lockport, Illinois on Monday April 11, 2016 at 6:30 PM for the purpose of holding a Public Hearing for the Town Fund Appropriated Budget for 2016-2017. Supervisor Ron Alberico presided. Present were Trustees, John Batusich, Mike Lewandowski, Dean Morelli, and Barb Boyce, Clerk Denise Mushro Rumchak, Assessor Debbie Mason, Deputy Clerk Michele Rutter and Jessica Strickland. Also present were residents Miriam Salvador, Carl Bebrich, Sue Bebrich and Grant Spooner filming the meeting. Collector Lance McCalla and Highway Commissioner John Cielenski were absent. The meeting agenda and public notice were posted at the Lockport & Crest Hill Libraries, at the Central Square Building, The Joliet Herald News on March 4, 2016, on the Township website (Clerk's section) and also the Board Room door. The Town Fund Budget was on display for 30 days in the Clerk's office.

Supervisor Alberico noted that changes were made on the budget, page 2 under contingencies from \$1,000 to \$10,000 on page 4.1 Clerk Secretary has been changed from \$21,599 to \$22,000, also changes to page 12 Dispatch salary from \$18,000 to \$22,880.

Supervisor Alberico opened the floor for Public Hearing to the public. Resident Carl Bebrich proposed that the budget be posted on the Township website so residents can review the budget before the hearing. Supervisor Alberico thought it was a great idea and will look into it further. Resident Sue Bebrich addressed the board on the importance of the horse community of Lockport Township. Sue Bebrich commented that the Township allocate monies for the horse community study. Supervisor Alberico asked three times if there was any more business for the public hearing. There were no more addresses or suggestions.
