ROAD & BRIDGE

The Lockport Township Board of Trustees met in the Central Square Board Room 318, 222 East Ninth Street, Lockport, Illinois on Monday January 9, 2017 at 7:00 PM with Supervisor Ron Alberico presided.

Present were Supervisor Ron Alberico, Trustees John Batusich, Barb Boyce, Mike Lewandowski and Dean Morelli, Assessor Debbi Mason, Clerk Denise Mushro Rumchak, Highway Commissioner John Cielenski, Attorney Gary Mueller, Deputy Clerk Jessica Strickland and Resident Grant Spooner filming the meeting. Also present were Residents Barb Delaney, Ron Cornolo and Cecilia Disomma. Absent was Collector Lance McCalla. The meeting agenda was posted at the Lockport & Crest Hill Libraries, the Joliet Herald News, at the Central Square Building, the Lockport Township website (Clerk's section) and also on the Board Room door.

On a Motion of Batusich, seconded by Boyce to approve the minutes from the previous regular monthly meeting held on December 12, 2016.

Trustee Batusich asked Commissioner Cielenski the details of line item #706-4206, 706-4209, 706-4210 and 706-4211. Commissioner Cielenski stated that these line items are an accumulation of full time employees' salaries, overtime for full time employees, part time employees' salaries and overtime for part time employees. Commissioner Cielenski also added that underneath those line item numbers, is the breakdown of each employee's salary for that pay period.

Trustee Morelli inquired about the bill for the Township Officials of Illinois that included drug and alcohol testing. Commissioner Cielenski reported this is a yearly fee the Highway Department pays. TOI will randomly drug test 100-200 employees in this state program. He also mentioned only two of his employees have been tested since he has been in office. Commissioner Cielenski expressed that the TOI program is great, but he would like to see his employees tested more often, especially with paying this yearly fee.

On a Motion of Boyce, seconded by Lewandowski to approve total bills and payroll in the amount of \$54,874.23. Roll call vote resulted in Alberico Aye, Batusich Aye, Boyce Aye, Lewandowski Aye, and Morelli Aye.

- The employees have been performing preventive maintenance on the trucks and plow equipment due the continuous breakdowns with the vehicles in the last couple of months.
