ROAD & BRIDGE

The Lockport Township Board of Trustees met at the Lockport Township Government Building, Community Center, 1463 S. Farrell Road, Lockport, Illinois on Monday December 11, 2017 at 7:00 PM with Supervisor Ron Alberico presiding.

Present were Trustees Gregg Bickus, Barb Boyce, Barb Delaney and Dean Morelli, Clerk Denise Mushro Rumchak, Highway Commissioner John Cielelnski, Attorney Gary Mueller and Deputy Clerk Jessica Strickland. Also present were- See attendance sheet. Absent were Assessor Debbi Mason and Collector Lance McCalla. The meeting agenda was posted at the Lockport & Crest Hill Libraries, Lockport Township Government Building, the Lockport Township website (Clerk's section), the calendar and also on the Community Center door.

On a Motion of Delaney, seconded by Boyce to approve the minutes from the previous regular monthly meeting held on November 6, 2017.
