ROAD & BRIDGE

The Lockport Township Board of Trustees met at the Lockport Township Government Building, Community Center, 1463 S. Farrell Road, Lockport, Illinois on Tuesday September 11, 2018 at 6:30 PM with Supervisor Ron Alberico presiding.

Present were Assessor Debbi Mason, Highway Commissioner John Cielenski, Trustees Gregg Bickus, Barb Boyce, Barb Delaney and Dean Morelli, Collector Karen Johnson, Attorney Gary Mueller and Deputy Clerk Jessica Strickland. Also present were Dave Meyer from Wermer, Rogers, Doran & Ruzon, LLC, Delinda Herod, Bob Loewe, Terry Broadhurst and Grant Spooner filming the meeting. Absent was Clerk Denise Mushro Rumchak. The meeting agenda was posted at the Lockport & Crest Hill Libraries, Lockport Township Government Building, the Lockport Township website (Clerk's section), the calendar and also on the Community Center door.

Supervisor Alberico commenced the meeting with a moment of silence for the commemoration of 9/11.

On a Motion of Boyce, seconded by Delaney to approve the minutes from the previous regular monthly meeting held on August 14, 2018.

On a Motion of Boyce, seconded by Delaney to approve total bills and payroll in the amount of \$95,929.24. Roll call vote resulted in Alberico Aye, Bickus Aye, Boyce Aye, Delaney Aye and Morelli Aye.

Commissioner Cielenski announced that the state is requiring all drivers who hold a commercial driver's license (CDL) to submit to a drug and alcohol test as a condition of their employment. The Highway Department needs to adopt this new drug and alcohol abuse policy (Resolution No. 2019-3). Commissioner Cielenski explained there are different disciplinary action options that can be implemented and he has chosen option 2: if the driver violates a drug and alcohol regulation a second time, they are terminated and also all cost associated with the SAP evaluation and rehabilitation will be the responsibility of the driver. Commissioner Cielenski stated that the Highway Department currently uses Midwest Truckers for drug and alcohol testing.

On a Motion of Delaney, seconded by Boyce to approve Resolution No. 2018-3 (update policies/procedures for the drug and alcohol abuse). Roll call vote resulted in Alberico Aye, Bickus Aye, Boyce Aye, Delaney Aye and Morelli Aye.

Commissioner's Report-

- There is construction currently at the corner of Briggs Street and Bruce Road. This location will feature several soccer fields when completed.
- The Highway Department has been replacing culverts and hot patching the roads as needed.
- There are catch basins located in the Bonnie Brae subdivision that need to be repaired. The engineer company is creating bid packets for this project.
- Bid packets are also being created for road work that needs to be completed.

- Commissioner Cielenski received an email announcing that a grant can be received for the program “Safe Routes to School” to help fund sidewalk repairs/construction.

- Residents are encouraged to call the Highway Department to report any street lights not working properly.

- The final payment for the lease agreement for the loader will be paid tomorrow and Commissioner Cielenski would like to update some of the department’s trucks.

On a Motion of Boyce, seconded by Delaney to adjourn the meeting at 6:40 PM.
