TOWN CLERK'S RECORD BOOK

SENIOR FUND

The Lockport Township Board of Trustees met at Lockport Township Government Building, Community Center, 1463 S. Farrell Road, Lockport, Illinois on Monday August 14, 2017 at 8:43 PM with Supervisor Ron Alberico presiding.

Present were Trustees Gregg Bickus, Barb Boyce, Barb Delaney and Dean Morelli, Assessor Debbi Mason, Clerk Denise Rumchak, Highway Commissioner John Cielenski, Attorney Gary Mueller and Deputy Clerk Jessica Strickland. Also present were David Skoryi, Deb Skoryi, Jessica Skoryi, Terry Broadhurst, Karen Johnson and Grant Spooner filming the meeting. Absent was Collector Lance McCalla. The meeting agenda was posted at the Lockport & Crest Hill Libraries, Lockport Township Government Building, the Lockport Township website (Clerk's section), the calendar and also on the Community Center door.

On a Motion of Delaney, seconded by Boyce to approve the minutes from the previous regular monthly meeting held on July 10, 2017.

Supervisor Alberico disclosed there is a corrected bill list in everyone packets. The original bill list that was emailed and posted had the incorrect total amount. Supervisor Alberico explained the bookkeeper was hospitalized and a mistake was made, but now it has been corrected.

Trustee Bickus asked why the Sprint bill total is half of the amount from last month. Supervisor Alberico commented he would have to review the bill and let him know. Supervisor Alberico also stated he will give Trustee Bickus a copy of the bill.

Trustee Delaney inquired about the Rendel's invoice in the amount of \$31.50 for Bus #2 repair. Trustee Delaney assumed the Rendel's invoice would be for thousands of dollars. Supervisor Alberico stated this invoice was for minor brake work for Bus #2 and previous repairs for Bus #1 was almost \$10,000.00.

Supervisor Alberico disclosed the new buses are being built now, but it will take longer than expected for completion.

Clerk Rumchak asked when the next shingle shot event will be held. Supervisor Alberico commented there is not a scheduled date as of now, but there is still money in the shingle shot line item.

On a Motion of Delaney, seconded by Boyce to approve the total bills and payroll in the amount of \$20,165.99. Roll call vote resulted in Alberico Aye, Bickus Aye, Boyce Aye, Delaney Aye and Morelli Aye.

Citizens Wishing to Address the Board- Terry Broadhurst stated Frankfort Township recently acquired mini vans for their transportation system. Terry asked Supervisor Alberico if the new buses are necessary. Supervisor Alberico explained the Township has looked at every possible option and disclosed that the vans are not compatible for the seniors to get in and out of comfortably. Terry asked how many passengers use the buses in a day. Supervisor Alberico informed Terry that it varies day to day.

Supervisor Alberico gave Trustee Bickus the monthly ride report as requested.

On a Motion of Delaney, seconded by Bickus to adjourn the meeting at 7:51 PM.
