The Lockport Township Board of Trustees met in the Central Square Board Room 318, 222 East Ninth Street, Lockport, Illinois on Tuesday August 9, 2016 at 7:15 PM with Supervisor Ron Alberico presided.

Present were Trustees John Batusich, Barb Boyce, Mike Lewandowski and Dean Morelli, Assessor Debbi Mason, Clerk Denise Mushro Rumchak, Highway Commissioner John Cielenski, Deputy Clerk Jessica Strickland and Grant Spooner filming the meeting. Absent was Collector Lance McCalla. The meeting agenda was posted at the Lockport & Crest Hill Libraries, the Joliet Herald News, at the Central Square Building, the Lockport Township website (Clerk's section) and also on the Board Room door.

Attorney Gary Mueller arrived at 7:08 PM.

On a Motion of Boyce, seconded by Batusich to approve the minutes from the previous regular monthly meeting held on July 12, 2016.

On a Motion of Batusich, seconded by Boyce, to approve the total bills and payroll in the amount of \$48,077.26. Roll call vote resulted in Alberico Aye, Batusich Aye, Boyce Aye, Lewandowski Aye and Morelli Aye.

Old Business- Supervisor Alberico reported on Tuesday August 2, 2016, the Township held their second shingle shot program for the year. There were a total of thirty-seven seniors who attended the event. In attendance were twenty Lockport Township residents on the east side of the river and seventeen Lockport Township residents on the west side of the river. Supervisor Alberico commented there is approximately \$8,600.00 monies left in the line item budget. This will allow the Township to schedule forty more seniors for the next shingle shot event on October 4, 2016. Supervisor Alberico informed the Board that as of August 8, 2016, there are already twenty seniors schedule for the next event. Assessor Mason asked how old residents have to be to schedule an appointment. Supervisor Alberico stated fifty-five years of age or older. Supervisor Alberico announced if any resident is interested in scheduling an appointment, please call the Supervisor's Office at 815-838-0380. Supervisor Alberico expressed he anticipates monies to be left over in the line item after the October 4, 2016 event due to insurance companies contributing their portion. Supervisor Alberico is excited that residents are taking advantage of this wonderful program.
