

TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-6

An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for Lockport Township, Will County, Illinois, for the tax year 2018, collectable in calendar year 2019.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Lockport Township, Will County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of one million nine hundred thirty-five thousand eight hundred eighty-eight and no/100 Dollars (\$1,935,888) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

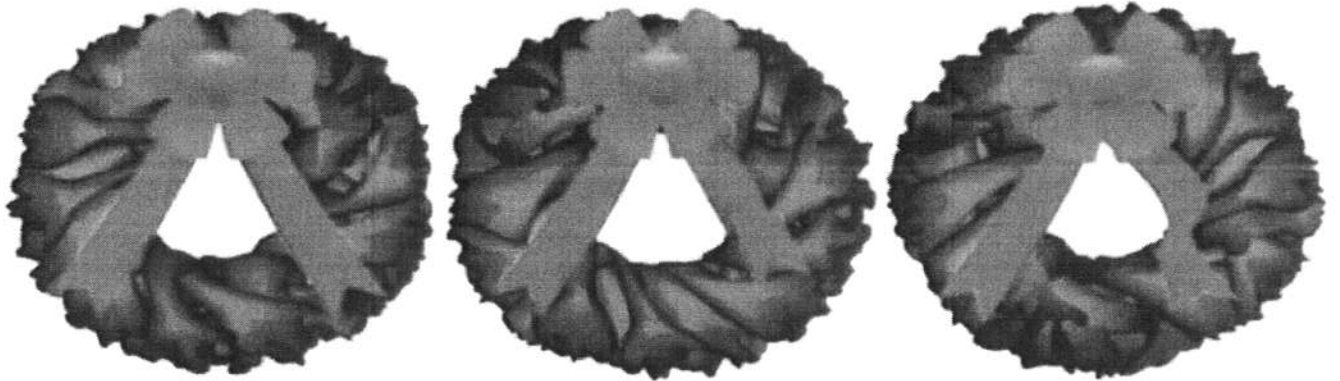

Dear Distinguished Trustees,

From picking out baby names, to buying baby books and imagining their baby growing, being an expectant parent is a time of excitement. However, this time is also accompanied by added stress and financial strain. When the baby is born, budgets will have to squeeze in new found expenses: baby wellness items, childcare, baby foods, doctors' visits, and more. For the average middle-income family, this will accumulate to \$12,350 annually on child-related expenses in their baby's first two years (USDA Report). With a poverty line of \$24,600 (the full time equivalent of \$11.83 per hour) for a family of four in Illinois, our families do not have a buffer in their budget or a savings account large enough to absorb these expenses.

Even with support from SNAP and WIC, families with infants struggle as neither program provides for baby wellness items, such as diapers or baby wipes. This leads one in three of our new parents to choose between diapering their baby or giving them a bath. Without 25 diapers, licensed daycares can refuse to provide care to a child. This means that struggling families cannot send their child to daycare, therefore keeping the parent home from work. With a parent missing work, the family's income is reduced and therefore their overall self-sufficiency and wellbeing is negatively impacted.

United Way of Will County's Community Baby Shower program works to increase the self-sufficiency of new parents in Will County through the creation of a local Diaper Distribution Network. The goal of this network, launched in September of 2018, is to provide families with needed baby wellness items. Each baby wellness kit or "Baby Bundle" has 25 diapers, in an effort to help parents keep their children in daycare and provide temporary relief by increasing disposable income.

Approaching a short three months of operation, the Community Baby Shower program has grown to have several corporate partners and community groups collecting diapers for kit-packing by volunteers and then distribution to families in need through five local Diaper Distribution Network locations, including Lockport Township. This has resulted in over 11,000 diapers and baby wellness items donated to date and 100 families helped across our network!

Lockport Township's support of the Community Baby Shower program not only highlights Lockport's firm commitment to helping alleviate the diaper need for families in their community; but our partnership will lay the foundation for greater community involvement and civic engagement among Lockport residents.

United Way of Will County asks that Lockport Township generously support the Community Baby Shower program through a grant in the amount of \$500. Together, we can unite our community and resources, empower our residents and create positive change. Thank you for your consideration.
